Thank you for your enquiry about becoming a Welcome Card holder of the International Dzogchen Community of Namgyalgar. By becoming a Welcome Card holder you are collaborating with the Dzogchen Community in the functioning of Namgyalgar and preserving the precious Dzogchen teachings. After three continuous years on the Welcome Card, you're eligible to apply for membership of the International Dzogchen Community of Namgyalgar. Once a member of the Community you are entitled to vote at Annual General Meetings and volunteer in 'official' positions and participate on Gakvil's (the managing committees of Gars, Lings and regional centres).

Application

Next step is to fill out an Application form which has a section for two current members of the community to propose you as a Welcome Card holder. If you are unable to provide two nominators, please still submit your application to the Gakyil who will consider all applications. Once approved, and contribution fees are paid, you will be notified. Your subscription is for 12 months and is renewed every year on January 1st. Contribution fees can be paid in full or in installments by credit card via pay pal in the online Membership Management System of the International Dzogchen Community (please see information in the Payment form).
